ORDER

(31.08.2009)

With the consent of the counsel for the parties, the matter is heard finally.

By way of this petition the petitioner is seeking regular pay scale on the post of Assistant Teacher.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that number of identical petitions have been decided by this Court and the issue involved is a concluded one. He has also referred to one of the orders in W.P. (S) No. 813/2007 (Ram Kumar Sahu v. State of Chhattisgarh) in which regular pay scale was granted from the date of initial appointment.

Counsel for the respondents/State submits that in the light of the judgment of this Court the petitioner may make a representation to the authorities concerned and the same would be decided after scrutinizing the factual and legal position.

Thus it is directed that if the petitioner makes a representation to the authorities concerned within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the same shall be decided within a further period of one month from the date of its receipt.

With the aforesaid observations, the petition is disposed of.
