- 3) Be that as it may, since it requires verification of facts, the matter is referred to the Collector, Surguja, to look into the grievances of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law.
- 4) Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
- 5) Consequently, I.A.No.1 also stands disposed of
