ORAL ORDER (30.06.2009)

With the consent of the parties, the matter is heard finally.

Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 16.12.2005 passed by the respondent No.2, whereby the petitioner was transferred from Mata Mahamari Anugami Unit, Raigarh to Bilaspur without following the transfer policy.



This Court, while entertaining the grievance of the petitioner had granted stay in his favour vide order dated 5.1.2006.

In view of the fact that this petition was filed in the year 2006 and stay was also granted in favour of the petitioner, the transfer order, so far as it relates to the petitioner is hereby quashed. However, the State Government would be at liberty to pass an order if the administrative exigency so warrant.

With the above observation, the petition stands disposed of.
