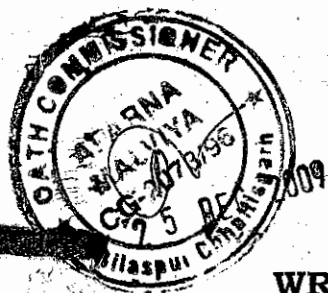

Advocate, for the respondent No. 1.</p> <p>Sri Bakshi submits that process of election has already been commenced and notification has already been issued on 24-12-2009.</p> <p>Prayer made by the petitioner is that the objections regarding non-inclusion of his name in the voter list has been raised but the same is not being decided by the authorities. The petitioner has failed to plead as to what was the last date for raising such objection in terms of Rule 10 of C.G. Panchayat Nirvachan Niyam, 1995.</p> <p>Therefore, the petition is liable to be dismissed and is hereby dismissed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to pursue his remedy before the authority concerned.</p>
