### **ORAL- ORDER**

**(Passed on 31/8/2009)**

1. This petition is under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (in short the Code) seeking direction to the respondents for proper investigation of the death of Kiran.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that dead body of the Kiran has been recovered in suspicion condition and matter Investigating Agency is not properly investigated the matter therefore suitable direction to give to the respondents.
3. Copy of the documents filed on behalf of the petitioner perused. It reveals that dead body of Kiran was found hanging in one room. Autopsy report reveals that body was putrefied therefore it is difficult to find that death was suicidal or homicidal. Including present petitioner no witness has come forwarded to say that Kiran has been murdered by any person at that stage, I do not find any lacuna the investigation, however if petitioner is not satisfied by the investigation then he is at liberty to take appropriate action under the provisions of Chapter-XV of the Code with the aforesaid observation, the petition stands disposed of.
