- 1. Heard learned Advocate Mr. John Lobo for the Petitioner.
- 2. Perused the petition. Petitioner's grievance is that by issuing certain executive decisions and publishing those in the Official Gazette respectively dated 2.3.2009 and 12.3.2009, the respondents have committed contempt.
- 3. It is seen that petitioner may be able to urge before the Court hearing of the writ petition that the orders passed by Government are passed with malafide intention and in order to nullify the pending writ petition. This however does not imply that the orders are intended to cause interference in the process of Administration of Justice.
- 4. Petitioner has not been able to demonstrate that there is willful disobedience of any of the orders passed by this Court.

- 5. There is no case for willful act of contempt of Court.
- 6. Contempt petition is therefore disposed of.
