JUDGMENT

This contempt petition by the first respondent in Writ Petition No.2870/2008 (GM-RES-PIL) is not on the premise that there is any violation or dis-obedience of the court order but for the reason that the writ petitioners who are arrayed as respondents – accused Nos.1 to 20 have all sworn to a false affidavit by stating incorrect facts before this Court in Writ Petition,



therefore, they are liable for the action in contempt jurisdiction.

- 2. We notice from the order passed in the Writ Petition that the Writ Petition itself was dismissed without granting any relief to the petitioners but with the observation that it is open to the petitioners or the other aggrieved persons to approach the authorities like the Pollution Control Board or the District Medical Officer, if any licence or permission is granted to start the Flour Mill in violation of the provisions of the Statutory provisions and etc., When the Writ Petition itself having been dismissed, the first respondent should have felt happy but has taken route to come back before this Court in contempt petition against the respondents.
- 3. It is not necessary for us to go into the question as to whether the petitioners had placed some incorrect facts or otherwise before the Court, as the petitioners have not been given any relief at all in the



Writ Petition and the Writ Petition having been dismissed, it is not necessary for us to enable him to initiate contempt proceedings against the respondents.

The Contempt Petition is dismissed.
