He undertakes not to create third party rights or damage the suit premises. He undertakes to clear up to date arrears within a period of two months from today and further pay Rs. 800/-(Rupees eight hundred) as use and occupation charges every month up to the date of handing over the possession. He undertakes to file his personal undertaking by way of affidavit incorporating the aforesaid terms within a period of four weeks from today. The petitioner/tenant understands the consequences of violation of the undertaking. Breach of undertaking shall not only tantamount to violation of order of this Court but shall also entitle the landlord to have the orders executed immediately. Petition disposed of.
