health condition of the petitioner has relied Annexure P-1 dated 26.10.2009 which has been issued by Dr. Rajiv Agarwal, Sr. Consultant & Interventional Cardiologist, Batra Hospital & Medical Research Centre. In the petition there is no averment that the petitioner remained under treatment of Dr. Rajiv Agarwal nor in the Certificate Annexure P-1 it has been stated that Dr. Rajiv Agarwal treated the petitioner and for that reason Certificate annexure P-1 is of no help to the petitioner with regard to his health. The petitioner has failed to make out a case for transfer of his cases from Dharamshala either to Una or Nahan. Accordingly, petition is dismissed.
