The grievance of the petitioner, as far as release of

pension is concerned, the same stands redressed. However, the

same has not been granted from the due date. According to the

petitioner, there is delay of eight months. The delay on the part

of the Corporation has not been explained satisfactorily. The

retiral benefits have to be paid as and when they become due.

Consequently, the petitioner is held entitled for interest at the

rate of 6% per annum from due date till the time the retiral

benefits were released by the respondents.

With the above observations, the petition stands

disposed of.
