## **ORDER**

This is a petition filed under Section 439 of Criminal Procedure Code seeking bail.

- Petitioner is accused in Crime No. 45/2009 of 2. Thirupuram Excise Range for the offences punishable under Sections 8(1) and (2) of the Abkari Act.
- 3. The facts are stated in the order of the court below, which is appended to this petition. Considering the quantity involved and also the fact that a good part of the investigation is over, bail can be granted.

The application is allowed as follows:

- 1) Petitioner shall be released on bail on her executing a bond for Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of JFCM concerned.
- 2) Petitioner shall not tamper or attempt to tamper with the evidence or influence or try to influence the witnesses.
