This is a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. filed by the accused in ST.No.1026/2007 of Judicial First Class Magistrate Court I, Pathanamthitta.

- 2. One K.A.Ashokan had instituted the above case against the petitioner alleging commission of an offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act.
