JUDGMENT

Petitioner is an Authorised Retail Distributor No.198 of Karunagappally Taluk. He is aggrieved by the reduction of the card holders attached to his shop. Petitioner refers to Exhibit-P2 instructions given by the District Supply Officer wherein it is maintained that a shop should have a minimum of 300 and maximum of 500 card holders. This has not been done in the case of the petitioner, it is contended. Hence the writ petition.
