J U D G M E N T

Petitioner and 4th respondent are brothers. Fifth respondent , their father executed a settlement deed in favour of the petitioner as per Document No.238/2000, covering an extent of 9 Ares and 50 Sq.mtrs. It is alleged that the 5th respondent later influenced the 4th respondent to cancel the said settlement deed and execute another document in favour of the 4th respondent. In the meanwhile,the property had been mutated in the name of the petitioner. That was also allegedly cancelled by orders passed by the 3rd respondent. Petitioner submits that he sought for a copy of the same. But it has not been given to him. He then approached the District Collector vide Ext.P3. Ext.P3 is pending before the District Collector. The 2nd respondent shall look into Ext.P3 and do the needful either by directing a copy of the order to be served on the petitioner or by taking other appropriate action, within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

Writ petition is disposed of as above.
