**JUDGMENT** 

Petitioner's vehicle bearing registration No.KL-7N-1845 has been

seized by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent on the allegation of contravention of the

provisions of the Kerala Protection of River Banks and Regulation of

Removal of Sand Act, 2001. The petitioner's grievance is that by Ext.P4 he

applied for interim custody of the vehicle, which has not been considered so

far.
