#### **WRIT PETITION NO.18256 OF 2009**

#### **ORDER:**

The petitioner filed this Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of Mandamus declaring the notification dated 19.06.2009 issued by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent pursuant to the letter Cr.No.10833/2007/CPE/E4 dated 30.09.2007 of the respondent No.1 bifurcating the erstwhile TTCS Veenavanka into TTCS, Veenavanka, TTCS, Narsingapur without there being any resolution passed by the TTCS, Veenavanka as arbitrary and illegal and consequently set aside the same.

- 2) The petitioners are residents of Narsingapur village and also the members of Toddy Tappers Cooperative Society (TTCS), Veenavanka. There are 61 members in that society and the petitioners herein are opposing the notification issued for bifurcation of TTCS, Veenavanka.
- 3) Apparently the order of bifurcation was passed vide notification dated 19.06.2009. Against the said order, the petitioners have an alternative efficacious remedy by way of appeal. Therefore, the petitioner is hereby directed to approach the competent authority and file an appeal in accordance with law.
- 4) Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
