ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in trying to dig canal through the land of the petitioners in S.No.71/2 of Pichipadu village, Chapadu Mandal, Kadapa District as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to dig canal through the land of the petitioner unless the same is acquired under the provisions of Land Acquisition of Act.

2) On instructions, the learned Assistant Government Pleader submitted that the respondents have never tried even to dig such a canal and they never interfered with the peaceful possession of the petitioners' land and the subject relates to LCB-04 package.

3) In the light of the said instructions received by the learned Assistant Government Pleader, this Court is of the view that no orders need be passed in this writ petition.

4) Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
