#### **WRIT PETITION NO.18238 OF 2009**

#### **ORDER:**

The petitioner approached this Court and filed the present writ petition with the following prayer:

"For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit it is prayed that this Honourable Court may be pleased to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, directing the highhanded action of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent herein in closing the complaint filed by the petitioner herein on 18.06.2009 which is registered as Cr.No.155/2009 upon the instructions of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent herein as highly illegal and arbitrary and consequently direct the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent herein to conduct the investigation uninfluenced and to submit the report before the concerned Magistrate after conducting due investigation".

- 2) On instructions, the learned Assistant Government Pleader submitted that as no offence is made out on the complaint given by the petitioner and the Station House Officer, Peddapalli, filed a final report before the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Peddapalli stating that the said complaint is false.
- 3) In that view of the matter, this Court is of the considered view that no orders can be passed in this writ petition. If the petitioner chooses, he may approach the Honourable Court concerned and file protest petition.
- 4) Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
