**ORDER:**

The petitioner filed the Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents frequently visiting the house of the petitioner and calling him to Police Stations without any crime or case as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents 2 to 4 to dispose of the representation of the petitioner dated 25.09.2008 and close the rowdy sheet against the petitioner forthwith.

2) On instructions, the learned Assistant Government Pleader submitted that the rowdy sheet has been closed on 05.12.2008.

3) In the light of the said statement, this Court is of the view that no orders need be passed in this writ petition.

4) Accordingly, the Writ Petition is dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
