**ORDER:**

According to the petitioner, he is the dealer in respect of fair price shop No.2501 of Pegadapally Village and Mandal, Karimnagar District and has been distributing the essential commodities to the cardholders without any blemish. While so, on 03.11.2009 the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent inspected his shop and seized the entire stock of rice alleging that there is variation in the stock, and later, submitted a report to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent. Pursuant thereto, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent issued a show cause notice No.G/1909/2009 dated 06.11.2009 calling upon him to show cause as to why his authorisation should not be cancelled and submit explanation within seven days. On the even date, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent also suspended his authorisation. Immediately thereafter i.e. on 13.11.2009 he submitted a detailed explanation to the show cause notice issued by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent seeking restoration of his authorisation, but so far no orders have been passed. The same is questioned in this writ petition.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Civil Supplies.

3. Having considered the submissions made by the counsel on either side and having regard to the fact that the petitioner has already offered his explanation on 13.11.2009 to the show cuase notice issued by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent is hereby directed to consider the explanation of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In the event of his failure to pass any order

within the stipulated time, the authorisation of the petitioner shall be restored and the essential commodities shall be supplied to his fair price shop so as to enable him to distribute the same to the cardholders, during pendency of the enquiry.

4. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
