MAHESH GROVER, J.

On 9.9.2009 this Court had granted interim protection to the petitioner after noticing the contention that the only injury attributed to the petitioner was simple in nature and the grievous injury had been caused by Sandeep, the co-accused of the petitioner.

Pursuant to the aforesaid directions the petitioner is said to have joined the investigation which fact has not been controverted by the learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh. That apart, it has been contended before this Court that the matter has been resolved between the parties.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the interim directions dated 9.9.2009 are hereby made absolute till the filing of the challan subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
