Pursuant to order dated April 16, 2009, report of the
Warrant Officer has been received, which reads thus:-

“On 19.4.2009, in compliance with the order passed in the aforesaid Criminal Writ Petition, I along with the petitioner and police officials of Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat visited the respondent brick-kiln, where all the alleged detenues (fully mentioned in para 4 of the petition) were found. However, nothing unusual was noticed, which could restrain their movements, as their hutments were situated on the main Road and there were also other brick-kilns in the nearby fields. One Janak Tyagi, who stated himself to be relative of respondent No.3, was present on the spot and he told that the alleged detenues should not have any problem there and if even then, they wish to leave the brick-kiln, they are at liberty to go anywhere. Thereafter, all the alleged detenues loaded their house-hold articles in a four wheeler and left the

brick-kiln.

In compliance with the directions issued in Criminal Writ Petition No.342 of 2008 to give a specific report, it may be observed that in the instant case, the stay of the alleged detainees on the brick-kiln, at the time of my visit, could not be termed as 'illegal detention'."

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
