Heard Sri Vivek Shukla, learned counsel for the petitioner.

The First Information Report has been lodged against the petitioner under Section 304-B, 506 I.P.C. and 3/4 D.P. Act. The allegations leveled against the petitioner are that he and his parents made unlawful demand of dowry from the parents of the deceased and on not fulfilling their dowry demand committed the dowry death of Smt. Priya.

As the allegations leveled in the F.I.R. are serious in nature, I am not supposed to embark upon any enquiry at this stage. The evidence is still to come and any order to be passed by this court would amount to pre-trial.

I do not find any merit in this case. The petition lacks merit and is liable to be dismissed.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, in case, if the application appears before the court concerned for obtaining the bail, the court concerned shall decide his bail application expeditiously and without causing any unreasonable delay.
