Heard learned counsel for the parties on the stay application.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the entire facts and circumstances, the operation of the impugned judgment and decree is stayed to the extent of eviction from the disputed premises provided the appellant deposits/pays the decreetal amount to the respondent-plaintiff within a period of two months and further continues to pays/deposits Rs.5,000/- by 15th of every succeeding month to the respondent-plaintiff. The respondent is also directed to furnish the details of his bank account to the appellant within a period of ten days.

Accordingly, the stay application is disposed of.

Learned counsel for the respondent seeks liberty to file application for grant of mesne profits.
