BY THE COURT: -

Contention of the petitioner is that she should be given age relaxation for the period she rendered her services as Apprentice with Jodhpur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited. Relaxation is claimed for appointment on the post of Technical Helper with the Ajmer Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Ajmer.

2) Respondents have produced for perusal of the court judgment rendered by the Principal Seat at Jodhpur in *Kishore Singh Vs. The Ajmer Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Ajmer & Ors.* (SBCWP No. 7804/2007) decided on 17/12/2008 wherein, it was held that such age relaxation would be admissible only in case Apprentice training is acquired by the incumbent with the same company with which he later sought appointment.

3) The controversy is squarely covered by the aforesaid judgment.

The writ petition is dismissed in the light of the the judgment rendered in **Kishore Singh** supra.
