Instant petition has been filed only with the grievance that despite petitioner having appeared in B.E. Final year ((8<sup>th</sup> Semester)), his result was arbitrarily withheld by respondents.

It has come on record that initially when OMR sheet was sent to the University, there were some typographical error, which shows that petitioner secured 42 marks out of total 40 marks; however, when this fact came to the notice of the Institution, mistake was rectified by making correction vide letter dt.30/08/08 (Ann.1) sent to the Controller of Examinations; in the meantime, result of B.E. Final year was declared on 28/08/08. However, there is no other impediment which may come in way of petitioner in not declaring his result. Once correction has been made by institution, itself, vide letter dt.30/08/08 (Ann.1), there is no justification to withhold result of petitioner.

Consequently, writ petition succeeds and is hereby allowed. Respondents are directed to

declare result of petitioner for his appearance in B.E. Final year (8<sup>th</sup> Semester) examination within seven days of submission of certified copy of this order and the same be communicated to the petitioner. No order as to costs.
