Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This writ petition has been filed challenging the order of transfer of petitioner dated 27.2.2009 and the order of Rajasthan Service Appellate Tribunal dated 4.6.2009 whereby appeal preferred by petitioner against the transfer order was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has cited the Government circular dated 14.7.1992 (Annex.6) and argued that according to the such circular in normal course a Patwari should not have been transferred outside the Tehsil and such transfer even if is made has to be so made for special reason. The Board of Revenue by order dated 30.10.1993 directed that said circular be strictly adhered to.

Transfer is a normal incidence of service and no government servant can insist for continuing at a particular place. If the petitioner feels that instructions issued by Board of Revenue are not being properly followed by the District Collector, he can approach either the Board of Revenue and/or the Divisional Commissioner.

With that observations and liberty, this writ petition is dismissed.
