Petitioner was appointed on contract basis as Shiksha Mitra for which an agreement was executed for a period from 06/12/2007 to 29/02/2008. His grievance is that he was not paid his salary after 29/02/2008 despite the fact that he is continuously working as Shiksha Mitra.

There is no extension of contract of service after expiry of the period referred to in Anx.1 and it is not the case of the petitioner that for the period during which he worked under the terms of the agreement he has not been paid his salary/wages. In absence of any further extension of contract, the petitioner has no legal right to continue and even from the material on record nothing can be inferred that he is in service after expiry of the period of contract, as observed (supra). If the contract has expired, no legal right is conferred to seek extension of contract or continuance of service.

Consequently, I find no merit in the instant writ petition and it is accordingly dismissed.
