18.50 quintals of grains in 37 bags is found in manual stitched while rice of 24 bags is found in machine stitched. No complaint from any consumer was made. According to the learned counsel, some damaged grain was supplied which was identified and filled in separate bags which have been made ground for anticipatory bail. Petitioner is apprehending his arrest which cannot be justified.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of one month from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nalanda, in connection with Rahui P.S. case no.27 of 2010 ,subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
