Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The two petitioners are named accused in this case carries allegation of assaulting the informant in a group. There is nothing specific against the petitioners except petitioner no. 2 that at the end of episode, he shots fire in the air. The informant has sustained a few injuries, but simple in nature on none vital parts earlier.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within four weeks of receipt of the copy of this order, petitioners, namely Sudhir Kumar & Mukesh Rai, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur in connection with Muzaffarpur Sadar P.S. Case No. 309 of 2009, subject to condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Criminal Procedure Code with additional condition to remain physically present before the court below on each and every date at least for two years or till disposal of the case whichever is

earlier, in case of failure on two consecutive dates, the liberty shall be deemed to be cancelled.
