Heard learned counsels for the petitioner, the State and the respondent-University.

The grievance of the petitioner is with regard to claim for triple benefit scheme under the relevant scheme of the University so as to enable the petitioner to have the benefit of pension, G.P.F. and gratuity.

It is submitted that the matter has been settled by this Court through several writ petitions.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-University submits that the claims of the petitioner shall be considered without delay as per law.

In the above circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for expeditious disposal of the pending claims as highlighted in this writ application, petitioner proposes to file a representation before the respondent no.3 with copy to the respondent no.2.

In such view of the matter, in case such representation stating details of unpaid claims is filed by

the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today along with the certified copy of the present order as also the copy of the relevant documents, if any, in support of the claim, the grievances of the petitioner raised in the representation shall be considered in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of four months on receipt of such representation which may be disposed of by a reasoned order.

The writ application stands disposed of with the above observations/directions.
