A counter affidavit has been filed today but it is not necessary to go into the averments made in the counter affidavit. From the admitted facts it is clear that father of the petitioner died in harness while in service under the railways in the year 1982. The petitioner, who is married daughter of deceased, applied for compassionate appointment in the year 2003 which was rejected in the year 2009 and thereafter O.A. no. 529/09 was filed before the Central Administrative Tribunal, Patna Bench, Patna which has been rejected by the impugned order dated 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2009.

Considering that death of the concerned employee was in the year 1982, the claim for

compassionate appointment made after more than two decades has rightly not been accepted.

We find no merit in this writ petition. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
