Heard Mr. J.P. Sharma for the

petitioner, and Mr. Sanjay Kumar No.I, learned  
Government Pleader No.14 for respondent nos. 1  
and 2. In spite of valid service of notices on  
respondent nos. 3 and 4, they have not entered  
appearance. The petitioner claims to be married  
to respondent no.4, who lived together and the  
marriage has been consummated. It is further  
stated in the writ petition that respondent  
no.3, father of respondent no.4, did not  
approve of the marriage and, therefore, kept  
her in illegal confinement, as a result of  
which she is unable to join the petitioner in  
her matrimonial home in spite of her desire. It

is, therefore, prayed that respondent no.3 may be directed to release respondent no.4 to join the petitioner. In the facts and circumstances of the case, we would not like to proceed further in this matter. It goes without saying that it will be open to the petitioner to approach the appropriate forum for the reliefs prayed for herein. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
