Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the Vigilance.

Petitioner is an accused in a case under Sections 7, 8, 13(2) read with 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act.

As per the prosecution case, Amrendra Kumar Rajak, an Assistant posted in the office of District Superintendent of Education, Hajipur, demanded a sum of Rs. 10,000/- and after receiving the said amount, accused Amrendra Kumar Rajak handed over the same to Sanjay Kumar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no allegation that petitioner demanded any money either from the complainant or his wife. He further submits that the petitioner is not an employee of the District Superintendent of Education office, Hajipur. The petitioner is in custody since 29.04.2010 and he has fair antecedent.

In the circumstances, petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 5,000/- (Five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Special Judge, Vigilance, Muzaffarpur in connection with Vigilance P.S. (Patna) case no. 36 of 2010 (Spl. Case no. 17 of 2010)
