The grievance of the petitioner is that upon his superannuation on 31st January, 2003 from the post of Assistant Teacher, Primary School, Shambhupura, Naubatpur, District- Patna although he has received all the retiral dues, however the G.P.F. has not been paid till date despite request.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-State submits that it appears that the petitioner has not put forward any claim before the respondent no.5.

In the above circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for expeditious disposal of the pending claims as highlighted in this writ application, petitioner proposes to file a fresh representation before the respondent no.5 with a copy of the same to the respondent no.4.

In view of the above, in case such representation stating details of unpaid claims is filed by the petitioner

within a period of four weeks from today along with the certified copy of the present order as also the copy of the relevant documents, if any, in support of the claim, the grievances of the petitioner raised in the representation shall be considered in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of four months on receipt of such representation so that the grievances of the petitioner may be settled without delay and upon consideration the admitted dues found payable may also be paid to the petitioner along with interest permissible under the rules along with the Chart indicating the details of payment.

The writ application stands disposed of with the above observations/directions.
