		therefrom has become redundant, in as much as,
		petitioner has accepted retirement from the post from
		which he has been retired without reservation of his
		rights and contentions in the writ petition and that too
[voluntarily.
		The Writ petition, accordingly, has become
		infructuous. The same is disposed of thus.
		Learned Counsel for the respondents submitted
		that appropriate steps would be taken in accordance
		with law as quickly as possible, but not later than 6
		months from today, to release and pay to petitioner all
ŀ		his retrial and terminal dues that are payable in
		accordance with law.
