The petitioner is aggrieved by an order dated 11-6-2004 passed by the Ci vil Judge, Sr Division No.1, Guwahati in Misc (J) Case No.21/03 arising out of M isc(Arb) 81/99.

Without going into the merits of the case learned counsel for the partie s have been extremely fair in submitting that it would be appropriate to resolve the dispute between the parties by referring the matter to the arbitration of M r BR Dey, Senior Advocate.

Under the circumstances Mr BR Dey, Senior Advocate is requested to enter upon the reference and to adjudicate the matter as soon as possible since the dispute has been pending for several years.

Learned counsel for the parties give an assurance that they will hand over all the necessary papers to Mr BR Dey, Senior Advocate so that he can expedit e the matter.

In view of the above, the impugned order is set aside.

The revision petition is disposed of. Send back the lower court records immediately.
