WP(C) 1147/2009 BEFORE HON'BLE MR JUSTICE I A ANSARI

None has appeared on behalf of the petitioners. However, Ms. A. Verma, learned counsel for the respondent Nos. 1, 4 and 5 is present. Heard also the learned S tanding counsel, Bodoland Territorial Council, appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 2, 3, 6 and 7.

The grievance of the petitioners, who have been working as Non-Medical A ssistants, relates to non-payment of their salary. However, from a communicati on, dated 05.08.2010, issued by the Department of Health & Family Welfare (A), G overnment of Assam, which Ms. A. Verma, learned counsel, has produced before this Court to-day, it transpires that subsequent to the order, dated 22.07.2010, passed in this writ petition, requisite sanction has been granted by the Finance D epartment, Government of Assam, enabling the said 42 persons, including the present petitioners, receive their salary.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in these writ petitions. These writ petitions have, therefore, become infructuous and these writ petitions shall accordingly stand disposed of as having become infructuous.

Furnish a copy of this order to the learned counsel for the respondents. The communication, dated 05.08.2010, aforementioned, shall be kept as a part of the record of these writ petitions.
