The grievance agitated in this Misc. Case is that the petitioners though are ser ving in their respective posts as L.P. Schools teachers under the B.T.C. and alt hough the respondent authorities are contemplating to terminate their services b ut their salaries have not been paid from November, 2006 till date.

In the Writ Petition itself an observation was made on 21-12-2009 that the pend ency of the petition would not be a bar for the authorities to examine the petit ioners' claim for payment of salaries on the basis of the decision stated to have been taken in this regard.

While reiterating the aforesaid observation made by this Court on 21-12-09, it is directed that the respondent authorities shall take such decision as early as possible preferably within a period not later than six weeks from today.

With the aforesaid observations and directions, this Misc. Case stands disposed of.
