This application is filed by the applicants All Deori Students Union and the General Secretary of All Deori Students Union with a prayer to implead themselves as party respondent Nos. 8 and 9 in the main writ petition. The prayer for impleadment is strongly opposed by the learned senior counsel, Mr. S.N. Sarma on the ground that the challenge made in the writ petition is against the impugned order dated 29.1.2010 (Annexure- 4 to the writ petition) issued by the Government, the legalities and otherwise of the same is to be examined by the court and students union has no role to play in determining the issues raised in this writ petition.

However, Mr. B.D. Goswami, learned counsel appearing for the applicants, submits that All Deori Students Union was not only a party in signing the accord between the Government and representative of the Deori Organization but also the applicants were instrumental in issuing the impugned order.

Having considered the rival submissions of the parties in the context of the issues raised in this petition, I do not find sufficient ground to allow impleadment of the applicants as party respondents. At this stage, Mr. Goswami, submits that he has no objection if the applicants are impleaded even as interveners. Accordingly, the applicants are allowed to be impleaded as interveners.

Registry is directed to correct the cause title showing the names of two applicants as interveners.

Misc. case stands disposed of.
