AWARD

(Passed on 30-10-2010)

Parties file a compromise petition. The terms are just. We hereby record the compromise and pass an award in terms of compromise, and order that respondent No. 3 shall pay to appellant a sum of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only.) by way of compensation, in addition to the amount already paid/awarded by the Claims Tribunal within a period of 2 months from today, failing which, this amount shall carry interest @ 6% per annum for the period commencing from the date of completion of 2 months till its realization.
