1. Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant and the learned APP appearing on behalf of the respondent-State. By an order dated 21st December, 2010 in Suo Motu Contempt Petition No. 4 of 2008, the Division Bench of this Court was pleased to grant stay to the order of conviction for a period of four months.
