FOLLOWING:

CONCILIATION ORDER

This MFA filed U/s. 173 (1) of MV Act against the
judgment and award dated 19-11-2007 passed in MVC
No.150/2006 on the file of the MACT, Ranebennur. The
Learned Counsel for the Appellant, the representative

 

of the Respondent and the learned Counsel for the Respondent are present.

2. After negotiations, the matter is settled. The Insurance Company has agreed to pay and Appellant has agreed to receive a lump sum compensation of Rs.1,52,200/- (Rs.One Lakhs Fifty Two Thousand Only) with 6% interest from the date of petition, in addition to what has been awarded by the Tribunal, in full and final settlement of the claim.

3. The Insurance Company shall deposit the said amount before the Tribunal within six weeks from the date of preparation of Award, failing which the said amount shall carry interest @ 9% p.a. from the date of default, till the date of deposit.

4. We are satisfied that the settlement arrived between the parties is just and proper.

5. From out of the entire enhanced compensation 75% (seventyfive) amount shall be released in favour of



the Appellant and the balance to be kept in a term deposit with a nationalized Bank entitling the appellant to withdraw the interest.

6. This Misc. First Appeal stands disposed of in terms of Joint Memo Award of the Tribunal is modified. Draw the Award accordingly.
