Heard. The petitioner has apprehension of his arrest in FIR 3 of 2010, dated 4.1.2010, under Section 452,323,506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the police report three cases of beatings are already pending against the petitioner in Police Station, Una. The petitioner is present today. He is a student under going training in I.T.I. and undertaken not to repeat such incident in future. His undertaking is accepted. Keeping in view his future, interest of justice will be met in case atleast this time his request for pre-arrest bail is accepted. Therefore, interim order passed on 8.1.2010 is hereby confirmed on the following conditions that the petitioner:-

- (i) shall join the investigation in this case as and when required to do so.
- (ii) shall not make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts and circumstances of this case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or the Police.
- (iii) shall not commit similar offence in future.

Needless to say that if the petitioner flouts any of the conditions aforesaid, the liberty of the bail shall be cancelled. The petition stands disposed of.
