Writ petition has been filed with the following prayers:-

- (a) That the respondent No.1 to 3 may kindly be directed to regularize the services of the petitioner forthwith and grant him work charge status w.e.f. 1.7.2001 when has completed 10 years daily wage services with them. They may also be directed to pay arrears of consequential benefits to the petitioner with interest @ 12% in stipulated period;
- (b) That respondents may kindly be directed to repatriate the services of the petitioner to his parent department forthwith in the interest of justice;
- (c) That respondent No.4 and 5 may kindly be directed to pay revised pay and allowances with arrears of revised time scale to the petitioner with interest @ 12% in stipulated period."

It is for the petitioner to bring his grievance to the notice of second respondent in which case the second

respondent will get an opportunity to look into the matter and take appropriate action. Therefore, we dispose of the writ petition as follows.

In the event of petitioner filing a representation within a period of three weeks from today, along with the copy of the writ petition, the matter be duly considered by the second respondent with notice to the petitioner and appropriate action, in accordance with law, shall be taken within another one month. Benefits, if any, flowing out of the said order, shall also be disbursed to the petitioner within another one month. Copy **Dasti**.
