The grievance of the petitioner as urged in this petition is that her services have been illegally terminated after she had regularly appointed as a midday-meal helper.

2. What I find from the record is that an inquiry was conducted by the Block Education Officer and, according to his report Annexure R-3, he recommends that the best possible person be selected after giving due publicity to this effect. Obviously,

this is the best way of recruitment even though the salary/honorarium paid is meager.

3. Without entering into that aspect of the matter, the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Mandi, District Mandi, will look into the matter, more especially, in terms of what has been stated in Annexures R-3 and R-4 and determine the respective rights of the parties. This petition is disposed of. All miscellaneous applications are disposed of.
