Rajiv Sharma, Judge (Oral):

Petitioner has assailed the appointment of respondent No. 4 to the post of Anganwari Worker in Anganwari Centre, Bhajol. Petitioner and respondent No. 4 have appeared before a duly constituted selection committee. Petitioner has secured 7.2 marks, whereas respondent No. 4 has secured 12.6 marks in the interview. In view of the recommendations made by a duly constituted selection committee, the respondent No. 4 was appointed as Anganwari Worker in Anganwari Centre, Bhajol. Petitioner has not alleged malafides against any member of selection committee. Once the suitability of the candidates has been adjudged by a duly constituted selection committee, this Court can not sit in appeal over the same.
