## **JUDGMENT**

## Joseph, J.

The prayer in this Writ Petition is to direct respondents 2 and 3 to give adequate and effective police protection to the petitioner for cutting and removing the trees standing in his propertiwa in Re.Sy.Nos. 468/4 and 468/13 of Block No.10 of Vengoor West Village engaging workers of his choice.

2. Briefly the case of the petitioner is as follows. Petitioner is the owner of certain immovable properties. He decided to cut and sell the trees for plantation of the property. He entrusted the work with one Mathew. When the said Mathew started the work, respondents 4 to 7, who claim to be officer bearers of Head load workers Unions affiliated to various political parties, demanded that they also should be permitted to

do the work. But due to internal disputes between the unions, the

petitioner could not continue the work.

3. We have passed an interim order, by which the petitioner can

employ workers equally from respondents 4 to 7. Though served, there

is no appearance for the respondents.

4. Accordingly we close this Writ Petition. We make the

interim order absolute and direct respondents 2 and 3 to give adequate

police protection to the petitioner for cutting and removing the trees

standing in his properties in Re-Sy.Nos. 468/4 and 468/13 of Block

No.10 of Vengoor West Village by engaging workers equally from the

unions, to which respondents 4 to 7 belonged.
