JUDGMENT

The petitioner has filed this writ petition complaining that a canoe owned by him covered by Ext.P1 licence, has been taken into custody by the first respondent and is retained by him. According to the petitioner, the canoe was empty at the time of seizure and did not contain any unauthorised article, including river sand. Therefore, the first respondent has no authority to retain the said canoe in custody. The petitioner has submitted Ext.P2 before the 2nd respondent seeking release of his canoe. Ext.P2 was submitted on obtaining the information from the first respondent that the canoe had been handed over to the custody of the 2nd respondent. According to petitioner, the detention of his canoe has been the cause of a lot of hardship to him.

2. Since Ext.P2 is pending consideration before the 2^{nd} respondent, it is sufficient that the same is directed to be considered and disposed of without delay.
