PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners are the accused Nos.1 to 4 in Crime No.300 of 2010 registered on the file of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) I.P.C. Apprehending arrest for the above said offences, the petitioners have approached this Court for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submitted that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State.

4. Considering the fact that this is a case in counter and also considering the fact that the injured has already been discharged from the hospital and the stage of the investigation, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Tenkasi and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned



Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 A.M. for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
